    - News regarding Better Together
    - She and other aldermen are working with the Municipal League to gather 6000 signatures from both the city and county in order to form a board of freeholders to give a second option for the city/county merger. The goal is to offer more transparency and avoid a forced merger via a statewide vote. They are currently collecting signatures and hope to have the needed signatures within the next two months.     - Repaving of Arsenal will begin soon (no specific start date available)
    - Applications available for those interested in having a speed hump placed on their block. Blocks will then be ranked and ordered by CSB and Megan. A speed study will be done by the Street's department. If there is sustained speed of 5mph or greater over the speed limit, the block will qualify for speed hump. Will continue to install bumps until allotted participatory budget funds run out.
