The South Grand Community Improvement District is very proud on what we have accomplished together in 2012. The district's mission is to cultivate a robust and supportive business climate on South Grand in order to establish the Tower Grove community as the premiere urban lifestyle district in the Saint Louis Metropolitan area. Together with the support from Mayor Francis Slay, Alderwoman Jennifer Florida, Alderman Steve Conway, Board of Public Service, and Streets Department South Grand is truly living up to our mission.

- Five new businesses opened this past year to the district: Bali Cargo Company (3203 S. Grand Blvd), Upcycle Exchange (3206 S. Grand Blvd), Rocket Century (3189 S. Grand Blvd), Bikram Yoga (3121 S. Grand Blvd), and Orkeed Restaurant (3191 S. Grand Blvd).
- The completion of phase one of the South Grand Great Streets Initiative and the beginning of phase 2; which entails a new traffic signal at Grand/Juniata, new street lighting, benches, bike racks, art installation, fencing around the planter boxes, completion of the sidewalk to Utah Place and the synchronization of the traffic signals.





WILSON **E**very year I am awed by the flood of support that the neighbors give to this effort and this year was no different. In our ninth year of supporting families in need through the 100 Neediest Cases program, we received generous donations of both cash, gifts, and effort. Our two families got over \$200 each in a combination of Target and grocery gift cards in addition to almost \$590 each for utilities that are paid directly through 100 Neediest Cases. This year we had such great volunteers that a few blocks received two fliers. We had so many people donate gifts that I could not walk to my front door with a clear path. We had gift cards and cash donations such that the families will get an enormous financial break for at least one month if not more.

One of the most enjoyable parts of this project for me is to wrap and divvy up the gifts between the family members. Since most of you do not get to experience that part I try to give you an idea of what they received. This year, I will have to be brief since the list is so long.



Gazette on CRIME

The news media scream it every day: "Crime is everywhere! It's happening in the cities, the suburbs, the rural areas!"

In our 2012 survey of Tower Grove Heights residents, a fair number of respondents mentioned crime among the issues that the Heights should address. They noted major crimes, nuisance behaviors, and even traffic violations as affecting our quality of life. [Full survey results can still be found on our web site <http://towergroveheights.com/>]

We posed a few questions to Captain Gerald Leyshock, commander of Saint Louis Police Department's 3rd District. Here is what we learned...

Q: Statistics have shown crime in our area steadily decreasing the past five years. But many residents don't feel safer. What is going on? Are we just getting more information on crimes?

A: Crime has been reduced in District 3 by 24% compared to last year. Residents become nervous because of high profile crimes, such as the armed robber who shot his victims after robbing them. Those types of crimes are unnerving and they weigh heavily on the minds of neighbors.

Q: Many of the suspects who are caught are 18 to 21 years old. Are juveniles – who are shielded from public view – also a significant factor in local crimes?

A: I don't have statistics to present of arrests by age, but we know from experience that many juveniles are involved in home burglaries and car break-ins. We have made several significant arrests of juveniles involved in recent burglaries.

Q: How effective are the citizen-involvement programs [e.g., Neighborhood Watch, Citizens On Patrol, Neighborhood Orders of Protection]? Are people phoning in suspicious activity very much?

A: Citizen-involved programs are very important in crime fighting. Gravois Park Neighborhood Association has been involved in Court-Watch and Neighborhood Patrols for many years. District 3 partners well with neighborhood groups. There was an important arrest in Tower Grove South of a burglar who ultimately confessed to six residential burglaries – a citizen had called in the suspicious behavior he observed, which led to this arrest. We encourage citizens to phone in any observed suspicious activity. They know their blocks and neighbors better than we do and they know when something seems amiss.



Q: Are there any new techniques or equipment that are proving valuable?

A: We use the new license plate recognition system every day. We move shell cars to different neighborhoods for visibility purposes. We invite specialized units to help us in areas of high crime, such as the Rapid Deployment Unit, Special Operations for South Patrol, and the Narcotics Division.

Q: What are some things residents need to do better to protect themselves and their property from crime?

A: We offer many tips at the neighborhood meetings we attend:



Know your surroundings and stay aware – at night, don't text or look down as you leave your car. Lock your doors and windows when away or asleep. Lock the doors of your garage. Keep your front porch and back yard areas well lit. Call 911 about any suspicious behavior.

Q: What are the activities and work duties of our Neighborhood Liaison in a typical week?

A: Neighborhood liaisons research crime in their designated neighborhoods, looking for crime patterns; look up suspects wanted for various crimes and distribute their pictures to District 3 officers; work with aldermen on special problems that arise; notify city agencies such as trash removal when necessary for specific problems; attend neighborhood meetings to provide updates.

Our TGHNA meetings, on the 4th Tuesdays, often provide updates on crime issues within the Heights. There is also now a Public Safety meeting series, on the 3rd Wednesdays, which concentrate on crimes and problem properties across Tower Grove South. All are welcome at these meetings.


